



VOICES OF IOWA DOCUMENTARY SCREENINGS



Voices of Iowa: Pearl Harbor is a powerful documentary honoring Iowans who witnessed one of the most defining moments in American history. Through firsthand accounts, archival imagery, and intimate storytelling, the film preserves the voices of veterans whose experiences shaped a generation.

As part of its statewide outreach initiative, the Grout Museum District home of the Sullivan Brothers Iowa Veterans Museum, is bringing this documentary directly to communities across Iowa—ensuring these stories are seen, remembered, and shared.

COST: \$100

SCREENING DETAILS & GUIDELINES:

- Documentary Run Time: 78 minutes
- Suggested Rating: PG-13 due to strong emotional content, discussions of war and death
- Digital marketing kit will be provided
- DVD's/digital version will be made available for purchase
- Voices of Iowa Interview Form must be printed out and made available
- No audio/visual recording of the documentary will be permitted
- A table must be made available for Grout Museum items: DVD's, Interview Forms, etc.
- All audio/visual equipment must be provided by the hosting organization
- Hosting organizations are responsible for ensuring audio and projection equipment is compatible with digital video playback.
- Veterans/active duty must always have free admission
- The hosting organization may charge admission at an amount they deem reasonable. The Grout Museum District will not be involved in ticket sales or revenue collection beyond reasonable marketing support.
