RECENT ACQUISITIONS

UPDATES EVERY 2-3 MONTHS

The Recent Acquisitions cases, located outside the McKinstry Library, feature donations made to the Grout Museum District. The contents of this case change quarterly.

Case highlight: Concrete scale model guard tower, bomb shelter, and Texas barriers donated by Major Robert Andreeson, US Army Reserves.

Andreeson was born in Grundy Center, IA in 1963. Between 1983 and 2010, he served in the US Army, National Guard and Army Reserve.

In 2005, he deployed to Iraq with 3rd Corps Support Command and was stationed at LSA Anaconda. There, these scale models were poured by the very Kurdish contractors responsible for constructing their full-scale counterparts.
