That creativity is essential as we continue to contend with the changing funding landscape from the loss of the voter-approved levy.

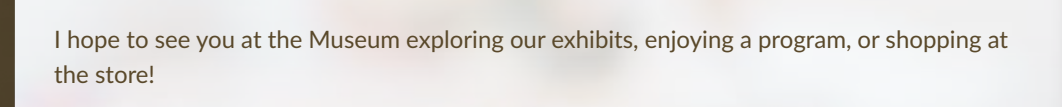
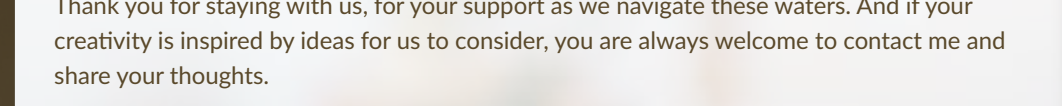
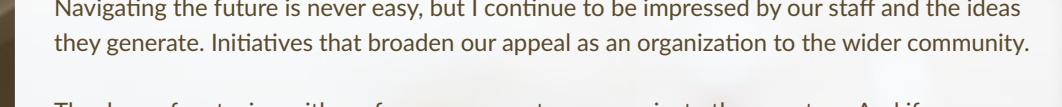
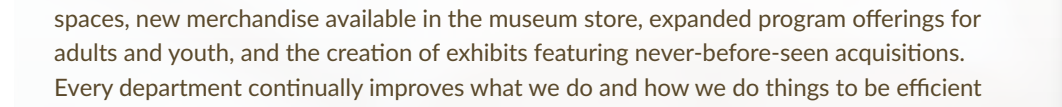
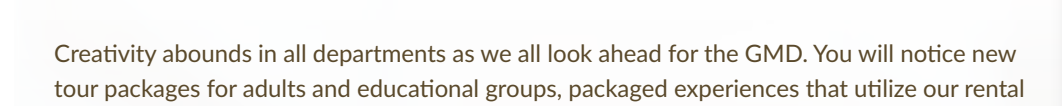
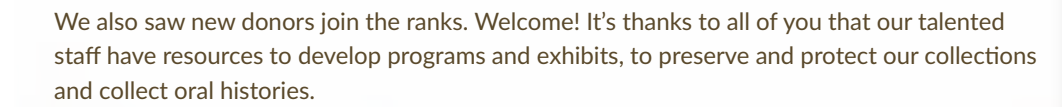
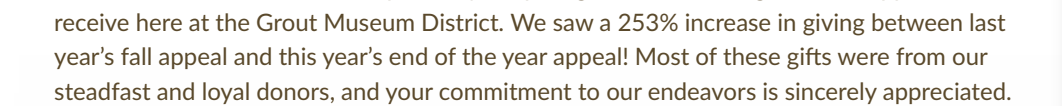
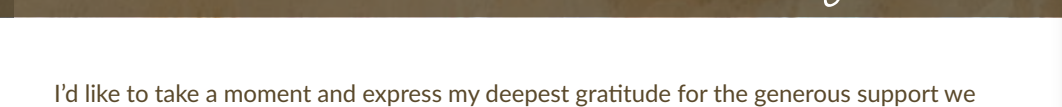
Navigating the future is never easy, but I continue to be impressed by our staff and the ideas they generate. Initiatives that broaden our appeal as an organization to the wider community.
